Minutes of Meeting of Punjab Water Regulation and Development Authority, held under the Chairmanship of Shri Karan Avtar Singh, Chairperson PWRDA, through Video Conference on Monday, 21nd December, 2020, at 3.00 p.m.

The Meeting was attended by Shri Sushil Gupta, Member, and Shri Surinder Singh Kukal, Member.

AGENDA ITEM 1

GRANT OF AD-INTERIM PERMISSIONS FOR GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION

The Authority broadly approved the process and powers to grant of Ad-Interim Permissions proposed in the Agenda with the following major modifications:

1. Each unit will be given a unique ID Number which should reflect the block where the unit is located and its type etc.
2. The permission will be issued after receipt of all required payments i.e. Application Fees, Tube-well Registration Fees and advance deposit equivalent to two-month (60 days) of groundwater extraction charges.
3. In case the application has already been submitted without the advance deposit and tube-well registration charges then the applicant will be asked to deposit the balance charges. The permission will be granted only after all the required charges have been deposited.
4. In case AO rejects the Ad interim permission, he will do so with reasons to be recorded.
5. In case of rejection by AO, the Applicant may re-apply or file objections. The objections shall be decided by the AO concerned. However, in case of doubt the AO may refer the matter to his senior officer as follows.
 - i. AO Level-1 may refer the matter to AO Level-2.
 - ii. AO Level-2 may refer the matter to AO Level-3.
 - iii. AO Level-3 may refer the matter to the Secretary or an officer designated for this purpose.
6. There will be three levels of Approving Officers based on the Water Demand of the Unit.

- i. Approving Officer Level -1 for applications up to 50 CuM per day i.e. 1500 CuM per month.
 - ii. Approving Officer Level -2 for applications between >50 CuM and <500 CuM per day i.e. between 1500 Cum per month and 15000 CuM per month.
 - iii. Approving Officer Level - 3 for applications 500 CuM per day or higher i.e. 15000 CuM per month or higher.
7. Unless the Guidelines provide otherwise, the unit shall be given 60 days for compliance of all the conditions of the Ad-Interim Permission (like installation of water meters, piezometers, etc.).

AGENDA ITEM NO. 2 - LETTER FOR AD INTERIM PERMISSION

The Authority discussed the format of the letter for grant of Ad-Interim Permission and conditions to be mentioned therein, and decided that the same may be modified and resubmitted in the next meeting.

AGENDA ITEM NO.3 - NOC CASES RETURNED BY CGWA.

1. The Authority took note of the list received from CGWA mentioning the status of 118 applications that had been received by it from Punjab.
2. It was clarified that: -
 - i. In accordance with the draft Guidelines there will be no exemption from payment of application fees, registration fees, groundwater charges etc. to PWRDA for applicants who have paid the fees or charges to CGWA.
 - ii. However, such applicants may seek a refund of the charges from CGWA. In order to facilitate such units, a letter will be addressed to CGWA requesting for refund of extraction charges deposited by the units.
